



## Trapp Family Lodge Outdoor Center Winter '20-'21 Pandemic Operations

We want everyone to enjoy their winter experience with us! Please work with our systems designed to maximize health, safety, and compliance with State of Vermont guidelines:

- Every trail user is required by the State of Vermont to register for contact tracing purposes and travel attestation (see posted signs with QR codes to complete registration)
- Your car is your base lodge! State of Vermont regulations have severely limited the number of people allowed in the Outdoor Center (10 upstairs, 10 downstairs, 10 in the Yurt). Outdoor Center priority is for those needing equipment rentals and/or retail. Port-o-lets are available at edge of Outdoor Center Parking Lot.
- Trail Passes can be purchased online by scanning posted QR codes. Show your receipt to a uniformed Trapp Family Lodge employee (wearing bright orange vests) to get your physical ticket.
- Cloth face masks (covering your mouth and nose) are required in all buildings, and when in the presence of others outdoors.  
\*Please note that the State of Vermont allows NO exceptions to this rule.
- Ski smart! Maintain distance between yourself and others. Ski safely! This is not an easy time for rescues.
- Snowshoe rentals are available in the Yurt.
- Ski and snowshoe rentals are available in Outdoor Center.
- Retail is available in the Outdoor Center.
- Our **Kaffeehaus** (8am – 2pm daily)  
**Bierhall** (11:30am – 9pm daily; reservations 802-253- 5750 or on *OpenTable*) and  
**Lounge** (11:30am – 3pm; 5pm – 9pm) are open for meals, and provide an alternative indoor space to the Outdoor Center.
- Check our “Trail Conditions” page for status of Slayton Pasture Cabin. The Cabin is limited to 10 people, so be aware that you may not be able to enter; be prepared to be outdoors for your entire ski/snowshoe. There is a fire pit outside the Cabin for people to warm up. Cabin status may change as the season develops.
- Two waxing benches are located in our new waxing shed on the west side of the O.C. parking lot. There is no public waxing space in the O.C. or the Yurt this season.
