The Von Trapp family has a long history with the Höpler winery in Austria. For over thirty years Höpler has bottled their Pinot Blanc and Pinot Noir with the Trapp Family crest on the label, a proprietary labeling. Austrian wines are becoming more popular across a broad spectrum of American restaurants and fine wine shops.

We'll taste a Pinot Blanc; this grape is also popular across the border in Alsace, France, a Gruner Veltliner; the signature white grape of Austria, a Riesling; much drier than the German versions you may be familiar with, a Pinot Noir; a grape Austria has gotten some very good press about recently and a Zweigelt; the most popular red grape in Austria which is a cross of the Blaufrankisch and Saint-Laurent grapes.
