Arguably the most spectacular of all white wine grapes Riesling is not very well known in the U.S.A. My wife for one categorically dismisses sweet wines, a vestigial response I'm afraid to the old white zinfandel mania in our fair country. Rieslings *are* sometimes dry though most of the time they have some sweetness which in the good examples is balanced by a crisp acidity. We will taste both dry and sweet versions.

We'll be tasting Rieslings from Austria, France, Germany and the USA.
